Our pen pal program has been getting more requests for folks who speak some languages that we don't have volunteers for. Some of those languages use a different alphabet than English, so it's almost impossible for our pen pal volunteers to have correspondence back and forth with them, even using translation apps.

But we want everyone to have support!

## OUR SOLUTION

When we know of a detained immigrant who speaks a language we can't communicate very well in, we will send them a nice handmade card from time to time to brighten their day.
