Volunteer your shelter to displaced residents— sign up to be a vetted host at Airbnb.com. You will be alerted through the Airbnb Open Homes Program.


Monetary donations: Boulder Office of Emergency Management and Community Foundation of Boulder County.

Items not needed may go to waste and get in the way of relief efforts. Listen carefully to public service announcements for needed items.
