PRAYERSTREAM COMFORT KIT BAGS SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

FABRIC GUIDELINES

- Please use a firm, cotton or cotton blend woven fabric—broadcloth is too light, denim or corduroy is too heavy.
- The same guidelines about images on fabric are: no pigs, military images, flags or religious symbols. Consider fabrics that would be appropriate for many genders and identities.
- Please make sure the ties and fabric are good quality. Use cording or knit fabric cut into 1 inch strips and stretched to create cording.
- Fabric: Cut one piece 12 in x 18 inches
- Cord: Cut two lengths appx. 12-14 inches

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Fold edge of fabric in (wrong sides together) 3/8 in on all sides (pressing with an iron helps) and stitch a narrow hem.
- 2 Fold down 1 inch on the two short sides (wrong sides together), press, then stitch the fold to make the drawstring casing.
- 3 Fold bag in half, right sides together. Stitch bag sides from bottom fold to casing seam. Stop before you stitch into the casing seam. Turn bag right side out and press seams.
- 4 Pass a cord through the casing, starting and ending on the same side. Repeat on the other side. Tie off cords.

Finished bag size should be appx. 11 x 8 inches Adapted from MCC's school kit bag pattern.
